# Water Distribution/Storage and Wastewater Conveyance Master Plan Class Environmental Assessment Study

### About this study

The City of Guelph, through its consultant Earth Tech Canada Inc., is completing a Master Planning study for the City's Water Distribution and Storage System and the Wastewater Conveyance System. The study will confirm the operations of each system to enhance reliability, efficiency and capability to service existing and new city residents well into the future as identified by the City's Local Growth Management Strategy (LGMS). The Master Plan is to identify preferred servicing strategies and related system improvement requirements for water distribution/storage and wastewater conveyance.

This study is being completed in accordance with Master Planning provisions of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process (September, 2007), under Ontario's Environmental Assessment Act. The Class EA process includes public and review agency consultation, an evaluation of alternatives, an assessment of the potential environmental effects of the proposed improvements, and identification of reasonable measures to mitigate any adverse impacts that may result.

### About the Public Information Centre

As part of the study, a **second Public Information Centre (PIC)** is planned to provide information on the study, an overview of the evaluation completed for various alternatives, and the proposed implementation plan for the preferred alternative solutions. Representatives from the City and its consultant will be present at the PIC to provide an introductory presentation, answer questions and discuss the next steps in the study.
