How to apply for a deck permit



Building permits are required for decks where the floor is higher than 0.6 metres (2 feet) above finished grade at any point.

Step 1: Zoning regulations

Zoning regulations apply whether or not a permit is required. The zoning by-law regulates the use of land, including the distance required to property lines. Refer to your survey for location of property lines. To confirm all zoning requirements are met, we recommend you contact Zoning Services staff at <u>zoning@guelph.ca</u> or at 519-837-5615 before applying for a building permit.

Step 2: Permit application

Building permit applications are required to be submitted electronically through the <u>Guelph</u> <u>permit and application system</u>. As a registered user you can check the status of your permit, pay fees and book inspections online. Ensure all required drawings are ready to upload in PDF format before starting your online application as per Step 3 below.

Step 3: Drawings to be submitted


All drawings listed below must be included and must be drawn to a recognizable scale (e.g. ¼ inch equals 1 foot). Partial plans or photos will not be accepted.

- A survey or site plan illustrating the lot width and depth, the location of the proposed deck (including setbacks to property lines), the size of the deck, and all existing buildings or structures on the property.
- A plan view illustrating the following:
 - Overall dimensions of the deck.
 - Size and location of posts.
 - Size and location of beams.
 - Size and spacing of floor joists and the direction the joists are spanning.
 - Location and width of stairs (if applicable).
- An elevation/section illustrating the following:
 - Height of deck (at highest point).
 - Type, depth and size of footings/foundation/piers.
 - Type of guard/railing system. For non-wood guards, include manufacturers name.

Step 4: Fees


Once the building permit application is deemed complete, you will be notified by email of the applicable building permit fee. Visit <u>guelph.ca/building</u> for the current fee schedule.

- 1. Drawings are for sample purposes only and shall not be used for construction.
- 2. Do not submit this drawing as part of your building permit application.
- 3. Details submitted for review shall be drawn to a recognizable scale. (e.g. 1/2" = 1'-0" or 1" = 1'-0".)
- 4. Any deck structure supporting a hot tub, swim spa or pool shall be designed by a structural engineer.
- 5. Refer to the City of Guelph Zoning by-law for zoning requirements regarding decks, pools, swim spas and hot tubs.
